 - Hence our Cassava Stem Loan Scheme which will reach so many farmers in different communities within the cycle of circulation.
 - With the processing, preservation and packaging factory in our farm, farmers in the targeted communities have no fear of market

2. To Improve the Health Of Our People

- ✤ By reducing hidden hunger
 - What is hidden hunger? Hidden Hunger is a lack of vitamins and minerals in our staple food. It occurs when the quality of food people eat do not meet their nutrient requirements so the food is deficient in macro-nutrients which they need for their growth and development. This we achieve through the production of pro-vitamin A cassava and orange-fleshed potato. Yellow Maize, Vegetables etc.
- We also encourage the production of quality vegetables including Cassava Leaves for adequate supply of Magnesium that is needed for the control of High Blood Pressure and improved-digestion. etc

Products of the farm include:

- Cassava peels for animal-feed formulation
- Cassava-chips
- Cassava for Starch Production
- Cassava for Flour Making
- Cassava for Garri production
- Cassava stem multiplication for market
- Orange fleshed sweet potato for chips, flour, juice, confectioneries etc.
